**The Qld** Department of Education is undertaking an evaluation exploring how <u>Respectful Relationships</u> <u>Education</u> is implemented in state schools. Our school has been selected as a case study for the evaluation. **Cybersafety Parent Session** is being held on Monday 13th May at 6pm. Babysitting will be provided in the Prep room. This session will cover supporting parents around internet safety and use of personal devices and creating a cyber safe household.

Dignity Vending Machine has been installed in the senior girls' toilets. Proudly funded by the Qld Government, Share the Dignity is providing students with access to free period products. As part of the initiative, we have access to Period Talk, an education program for students in Years 5-8, developed by Talk Revolution. The program is designed to ensure the current generation of children and young people are informed and at ease talking about periods. We will be in touch with parents of students in Years 5 and 6 in the coming term with more information on this program.

**Reading** The updated English curriculum presents a shift in teaching practices for reading that is closely aligned to contemporary reading research. The updated curriculum has removed references to students using their visual memory to learn to read and spell words. We teach letter-sound correspondences so that students can decode all words. At the same time, they engage with rich authentic curriculum texts through shared reading and discussion so their language skills are also being developed. Please see the parent brochure with the newsletter for more information. Information sessions for parents will be held at school on Monday 29th April at 3:15pm and again on Monday 27th May at 6:00pm. These sessions will be the same information.
