Under this agreement for 2019

Bunker's Hill State School will receive

\$64,765*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving at or above Regional Benchmarks in Reading from 82% to 90%.
- Increase the number of school scores at or above the national average to 20 of the 30 performance measures in NAPLAN (up from 13 in 2018).
- Support student learning to enable 90% of students to achieve a C grade or higher in English.

Our initiatives include


- Maintaining and building upon effective school processes of examining student data, using this to inform teaching, and case managing students with learning needs, including those students requiring extension (*Sharratt and Fullan, 2012: Putting FACES on the Data*).
- Building teacher and teacher aide capacity in the teaching of writing, linking this to the teaching of reading, and building this into school and classroom practice (*Archer and Hughes, 2011: Explicit Instruction and others*).
- Implementing support strategies identified in the case management of students (*Fisher, Frey and Hattie, 2016: Visible Learning for Literacy*).

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employing teachers to facilitate data review, case management and planning	\$40,000
• Accessing external professional development activities	\$5,000
• Purchasing additional Speech Language Pathologist services	\$5,500
• Facilitating coaching and feedback processes for teachers	\$4,000
• Designing and resourcing support programs for students	\$10,265
TOTAL	\$64,765
