

Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2022

Bunker's Hill State School will receive

\$74,806

This funding will be used to

- Ensure all students are achieving at or above Regional benchmarks in reading, or are receiving support to improve their reading.
- Extend students so that 45% of Year 3 students and 35% of Year 5 students are achieving in the Upper 2 Bands in Reading and Numeracy in the National Assessment Program, Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN).
- Increase student engagement in learning, measured by increasing the percentage of students in the School Opinion Survey who are interested in their schoolwork from 80% to 90%, and students who like being at school from 85% to 90%.

Our initiatives include

- Building on existing school processes of collecting and analysing student data, and use this data to inform teaching in the classroom (Sharratt and Fullan, 2012: *Putting Faces on the Data*).
- Building teacher capacity in matching teaching approaches to their students and the subject matter to maximise student learning and engagement (Queensland Government, 2015: *Age-Appropriate Pedagogies for the Early Years of Schooling*)
- Designing and implementing support and extension programs for students, and tracking the impact of these programs using data (Fisher, Frey and Hattie, 2016: *Visible Learning for Literacy*).

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Releasing teachers for data review, professional development and planning | \$30,000 |
| • Employing teacher aides to facilitate support and extension programs for students | \$30,000 |
| • Enabling quality professional development for teachers and teacher aides | \$ 7,906 |
| • Extending Speech-Language Pathology services within the school | \$ 6,900 |
